Gathering of new favourable contacts which will be useful for the mutual cooperation and new projects with an international participation (projects devoted to the research, education, popularisation of French study programs in V4 countries and in abroad).

All papers presented during the conference will be published in the peer-reviewed scientific journal Romanistica Comeniana (the entire issue will be devoted to the contributions of PhD students and invited speakers; reviews will be provided by the constituted scientific committee of the conference).
